Hourly: \$25-29/hour

Hours: Approximately 6.5 hours per week; may be combined with the Part-Time High School Biology Teacher position, and/or the Part-Time Elementary and Middle School Science Teacher position

Job Requirements

- 3 or more years of experience teaching High School science in a classroom setting
- 3 or more years of experience working with children
- Passion for one or more areas of science
- Bachelor's Degree and California Teaching Credential in Chemistry required
- Enthusiasm for educational options for homeschooled, gifted, and twice exceptional students
- Experience working with homeschooled, gifted, and/or twice exceptional students preferred
- Exceptional people skills, including strong verbal and interpersonal communication skills
- Ability to interact with children with compassion and courtesy
- Fingerprinting required

Job Duties

- For 30 weeks of instruction and 4 additional weeks of training and prep, beginning in Fall 2020 teach the following class that will meet for 75 minutes twice per week; set up and clean up and prep time will be allocated for each class period
High School Chemistry, grades 9-10 (twice per week on Mondays and Wednesdays from 9:00-10:15); this class will be online for Fall 2020 and is planned to return to our Fullerton location for Spring 2021
- Communicate with parents via email weekly to keep them apprised of student learning
- Maintain an online gradebook for each high school level class
- Set up before and clean up after class as needed, which may include moving tables and chairs when class meets in person
- When class is in person, walk up and down stairs several times per day; lift up to 25 pounds as needed
